### Inauguration of the RLC Global Secretariat in Bonn on May 26, 2014

Since 2011, the Center for Development Research (ZEF) has been hosting the German Campus of the “Alternative Nobel Prize”, the Right Livelihood College (RLC). Funded by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) and the University of Bonn, the RLC Campus Bonn is now one out of seven worldwide. In May 2014, RLC’s headquarter for global research and education, the Global Secretariat, will move from Penang, Malaysia, to Bonn.
