SABIO is an international research group that works closely with partners in Argentina, Brazil, and Uruguay to deliver evidence-based policy recommendations to foster sustainable and equitable bio-based transformations. We are looking for motivated co-workers who are interested in topics related to sustainable development and trade-offs / synergies between environmental and socioeconomic outcomes in Latin America. The student assistants are expected to work between 9-14 hours per week and the position will have the duration of one year, with possibility of extension. Because of the current restrictions related to COVID-19, the work will be carried out remotely.

We expect the student assistants to support the group leader and the three PhD students in the following activities:

- Review and summarize academic literature
- Search for secondary data and help design questionnaires for data collection
- Clean and manage datasets
- Write blog entries and news updates for the SABIO website
- Support the organization of online events

Requirements:

- Currently enrolled in a Master program in Economics, Agriculture, Geography or related disciplines
- Experience or interest in Latin America, agricultural development and environmental conservation
- Excellent speaking and writing skills in English (knowledge of Portuguese, Spanish or German would be an asset)
- Good knowledge of STATA or R
- Familiarity with GIS and remote sensing software is an asset
